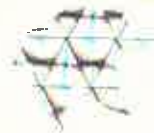

The Controlled Goods Program (CGP) is pleased to inform you the application for the registration of Tempo Aerospace Inc. has been approved. Your Certificate of Registration is enclosed. Your registration with the CGP will expire on **November 12, 2024**.

Throughout the period of your registration, and in order to maintain it, you must comply with all legal requirements associated with the CGP, including those conditions specifically provided in section 10 of the *Controlled Goods Regulations* (CGRs). Failure to maintain compliance with statutory requirements while registered in the CGP constitutes an offence for which a registered person may be prosecuted.

If you haven't already been contacted by a member of the Compliance Inspections Division of the Controlled Goods Program, you may be shortly. Your facility may be inspected to determine compliance with all conditions of registration; any deficiencies will be brought to your attention for correction. Be advised that failure to correct any such deficiencies and to otherwise demonstrate compliance may result in suspension or revocation proceedings against Tempo Aerospace Inc. pursuant to the *Defence Production Act* (DPA) and the CGR.

**Note** - it is your responsibility to submit a renewal application prior to the expiry date of your certificate. We recommend that you forward your renewal application at least three months prior to the expiry date to allow sufficient time to process it. Should you fail to renew your certificate on time, your registration in the CGP will expire and you will no longer be authorized to examine, possess or transfer controlled goods.
